

# 4<sup>th</sup> Grade Suggested Class Supply List

**\*\*VERY IMPORTANT\*\***

Please clearly identify all supplies/personal property with your child's name in permanent marker.

These supplies are for your child's own personal use. These items will be used for distance learning AND for our return to the classroom since students must have personal supplies. There will be no community supplies! Keep extra supplies at home for replenishing when needed.

- **Small, plastic supply box (approximately 8" X 5").** Desks will be frequently monitored for organization, and pencil boxes help reduce the clutter and protect student property from disappearing. They must not be too large since the desks are rather small. Just large enough to hold pencils, pens, a small box of crayons, and small glue stick, and a pair of small scissors.
- **One three-ring binder with 1" rings.**
- **Five binder pocket dividers with tabs, labeled in this order: Homework, Language Arts, Math, Social Studies, Science.** Please label at home!
- **1 Pee-Chee style folder, labeled as Desk Folder.**
- **250 sheets of white, WIDE RULED (not college ruled), lined notebook paper-WITH margins and NOT spirally bound** (Keep no more than 50 sheets in the notebook and save the rest at home for refilling and homework).
- **1 Spiral Notebook, 80 to 100 pages labeled as Writing Journal.**
- **Whiteboard 9" X 12", essential for Zoom instruction and interactions.**
- **Whiteboard markers, enough for the entire year, pack of 3-5, multiple black and ! Label with name, no yellow or fine point.**
- **Whiteboard marker eraser or equivalent** (old sock or washcloth works).
- **Pencils & Erasers** (Enough to last the entire year. The large pink erasers work best. Students can use a pen to write their initials on them. **Mechanical pencils are allowed but will be taken if causing a distraction!**)
- **Pencil Sharpener.** We will have sharpeners, but suggest students get hand sharpeners with small containers to catch the shavings.
- **Set of colored pencils.**
- **Small box of Crayons** (12 or 16 colors).
- **8-10 pack of colored markers.**
- **Scissors-Child-size, blunt ends.**

- **Multicolored pack of highlighters:4 Colors-Green, pink, orange, yellow.**  
Students will be highlighting or underlining important information in work throughout the entire year, and will also be using for editing writing.
- **Pens for correcting-No RED pens allowed.**
- **Backpack-** This is your child's briefcase. It should be **LARGE** enough and **STURDY** enough to hold the binder and several books. Rolling backpacks are suggested, but not required.
- **One JUMBO size stretchy fabric book cover for reading book.**
- **Ruler - Metric and Standard scale (mm and inches).**
- **Protractor**
- **Headphones/Earbuds (to be used only by your child).**
- **1 small container of playdough** for First Week activity.
- **1 to 3 Glue Sticks**
- **1 Large Bottle of MULTIPURPOSE glue**

**For when we return to the classroom:**

- **Scotch Tape** (disposable dispense rolls)
- **Hand Wipes**
- **Clorox Wipes**
- **Hand Sanitizer**
- **Tissue for personal use.**
- **2 Reams of white copy paper**

**For use at home:**

- **Multiplication and division flashcards up to the number 12.** For use at home if your child has not mastered the facts, also a good tool for review and practice.
- **Very Important:** Please make available a quiet, comfortable workplace in your home where your child can do homework free from distractions. Avoid having a TV within sight or hearing of your child during homework. Also, a place in your home where you can display your child's work will demonstrate the value you place on their academic achievement.
- **Grade-level appropriate dictionary and thesaurus-** This will be used at home extensively for spelling/vocabulary activities. It is critical that this be an elementary or intermediate level
