



## **First Grade Supply List for Distance/Hybrid Learning**

**Mrs. Chavez, Mr. Jacob, Ms. Kirk-Warner:**

The following are suggested supplies students will need. Textbooks and workbooks for reading, math, and handwriting will be provided to you to use at home.

\*\*\*We recommend a quiet place to attend zoom class meetings and to work on assigned work. Examples would be a desk or table with a chair in a quiet area. A laptop/iPad for daily individual use and wifi is needed. If you don't have this contact the district.

### **This is what students will need at home and will bring to school when we can return:**

- 1.) A box of 24 crayons, colored pencils, 2 number 2 pencils/erasers, a pencil sharpener, a glue stick, scissors, and a container for storage. No markers or pens will be used.
- 2.) A set of watercolors: prang brand is best (please no set with plastic brush heads, it doesn't absorb the water or paint).
- 3.) Paper: supply of white copy paper, handwriting paper with the dotted lines for kids and a spiral notebook for journaling.
- 4.) 2 folders: one for classwork in progress and one for math
- 5.) A pair of headphones or earbuds
- 6.) index cards for making flash cards

### **These are some items that we are suggesting for the students to use. Many activities will be done on technology, but it is also important for students to use their hands and develop fine motor skills. These will stay at home when we return to school:**

- Stem science building materials: straws, pipe cleaners, playdough, toothpicks, legos, toilet paper cardboard inserts, blocks, tape, index cards, construction paper,.....any items they can create with. (These can be from around the house and a lot from stores like Dollar Tree)
- math manipulatives: any small items to move around and count with, dice, playing cards
- A pack of multi-colored construction paper
- sidewalk chalk
- printer (optional): virtual activities will be assigned but optional printable worksheets will also be sent
