

Ms. Kirk-Warner's First Grade Class list for Distance/Hybrid Learning:

Dear Parents,

The following are suggested supplies students will need. Many items you may already have. Due to Covid 19, teachers will not be able to provide any of these supplies for home use.

Class list of what students will need at home and will bring to school when we can return:

- 1.) A quiet place to attend zoom class meetings and to work on assigned work. Examples would be a desk or table with a chair in a quiet area.
- 2.) A box of 24 crayons, colored pencils, 2 number 2 pencils/erasers, a pencil sharpener, a glue stick, scissors, and a container for storage. No markers or pens will be used.
- 3.) A set of watercolors: prang is best (please no set with plastic brush heads, it doesn't absorb the water or paint).
- 4.) Paper: supply of white copy paper, handwriting paper with the dotted lines for kids and a spiral notebook for journaling.
- 5.) 2 folders: one for classwork in progress and one for math
- 3.) A pair of headphones or earbuds
- 4.) index cards for making flash cards

Items that are needed but will stay at home when we return to school:

- math manipulatives: small items they can count and manipulate. 20 connecting cubes or legos all the same size. Additional Ideas will be shared as lessons are taught.
- Stem materials: straws, pipe cleaners, playdough, toothpicks, legos, tp inserts, blocks, tape, index cards, construction paper,.....any items they can create with. They can be from around the house. I buy a lot from the dollar tree. We will at time have projects.
- A pack of multi-colored construction paper.
- A laptop/ipad for daily individual use. If you don't have this contact the district.
- wifi
- printer (optional): consumables will be provided and online activities will be assigned but optional printable worksheets will be sent too.
